Donald Edward Woodcock of Ironton, Missouri passed away June 16, 2020 in St. Louis, Missouri at the age of 88 years. He was born September 27, 1931 in Leadwood, Missouri the son of the late Otto and Gertrude (Clay) Woodcock.

He was a master storyteller and he loved to tell jokes. As he got older, his jokes may have gotten more and more corny, but it still never prevented him from telling them.
